



MOOR 2 SEA 2012

Thank you for your booking or enquiry and we look forward to meeting you.

The start point will be in the car park of Travelodge hotel at Junction 27 on the M5 motorway. We will offer you free tea or coffee at the start. You should aim to arrive by 0930 and we will start you about 1030. **Finish point** is back at J27. Pre-entered cars only.

Warning

- There is virtually no fuel available en route. Make sure you have plenty before you start. There is a garage at the start point.
- Mobile phone reception is very erratic on Exmoor. If your phone does not work, flag down another MG and their phone might.
- There are lots of bends and open moorland so take your time and watch out for loose ponies and mad motorcyclists.
- Some of the minor roads are single passing roads so be prepared to reverse and don't travel in a string of MGs just to avoid navigating.

En route

- We are going to have games on the way and the route plan will give warning. Look out for our marshals in reflective yellow jackets.
- There are numerous places to have lunch and we will point these out in the route plan.
- Please take note where we tell you to use a low gear or you could suffer brake fade. They are steep hills!
- The cream tea, raffle and prize giving will not commence before 1500 so there is no point in racing.

Directions

From Bristol and the North:

Use M5 and leave at Junction 27. From the Junction 27 roundabout over the M5, turn left onto the A38 Wellington Road. You will see the Travelodge on the right. The car park is the **start point**. There is also a Burger King and

Costa Coffee here. Some 500 metres farther on is the Waterloo Cross pub and hotel where we will be holding our Saturday evening meal and get-together. Within 2 miles on the other side of the M5 is the Globe Inn at Sampford Peverell (1st exit off main north Devon link road A361 from M5) or camping at The Minnows Touring Park (details below).

From the South and East

A303 or A35 to Honiton. Then take A373 to Cullompton. Join M5 northbound dir. Bristol at Junction 28 and then leave at Junction 27, turning right over the M5 onto A38 Wellington road.

From the West

A38 or A30. Join M5 and leave at Junction 27. Turn right over M5 on to Wellington Road (A38)
